Class Sections: A class section is a defined teaching unit, identified by discipline and number, meeting a defined time in a classroom, online, and/or a combination of these modalities. Undergraduate class sections are defined as a section in which a learner is seeking undergraduate credit. Graduate teaching classes and non-credit classes and individual instructor assignments are excluded, including non-credit classes, distance learning classes, and individual instructor assignments. Each class section should be coded by discipline and held to be defined by the following.

Class Subsections: A class subsection includes a class, a lab, a section, and a discussion section. A subsection is defined as a section in which a learner is seeking undergraduate credit. A lab, a section, a discussion class, and individual

Using the above definition, the following table shows the number of class sections and class subsections offered in Fall 2019. For example, a lecture class with 800 students would be counted as one section in the 100+ column in the class section column and 40 subsections in the 20-29 column of the class subsection table.
