

France: Université de Lille

Through this program, students may choose to spend either a year or a semester in France at the University of Lille. Two primary exchange plans are offered at Lille: one for experienced French speakers, and another for students with little or no French who wish to study French language intensively as well as taking other courses taught in English. Upon arrival in France, students undergo an expansive 10-day orientation program to assist in immersion and general cultural acclimation. Several excursions within and outside of the city are provided by the university.
